The Farms Golf Club has a rich tradition in golf and places a high value on the traditions and etiquette that are inherent in the game of golf. We ask all members and guests to conduct themselves with this respect while on property. Below are some helpful hints to ensure you have a memorable and positive experience.

ENTERING THE CLUB

Please enter The Farms and pull forward to the main entrance, where you may unload your clubs and use the buzzer for bag service. Our staff will transport your clubs to the golf operations area and set them up with a golf cart. Once inside the clubhouse, turn right and proceed down the hall to the locker rooms – men to the left, women to the right. A locker will be available for your use and you may change from your street shoes at that time.

DRESS CODE

The Dress Code is established, in part, to ensure the common enjoyment of the Club and to maintain long-standing traditions and standards. We ask that gentlemen wear collared golf shirts that are tucked in, and that caps be worn forward. Ladies are asked to wear proper golf attire on the course. Children brought to the Farms should adhere to the same dress code as ladies and gentlemen. Please remember that men are to remove caps when in dining areas of the clubhouse.

GRATUITIES

The Farms Golf Club is a non-tipping club with the exception of caddies, cart attendants, and the shoe service attendant, which may be at your discretion.

ON THE COURSE

The Farms Golf Club believes that pace of play is part of creating a memorable golf experience. We ask that each group keep pace with play in front of you at all times. The Professional Staff will be present to help each group achieve their goal of a less than four hour round.

CELL PHONE POLICY

The audio use of cell phones is prohibited on the practice facilities, and all dining areas of the club. The use of cell phones for checking messages, or other “non-verbal” uses of today’s smart phone technology that do not burden or interfere with others, is permitted. It is the member or guests responsibility to make certain that others cannot hear any conversation during a call even in an area that calls are allowed.
